The wise old tortoise Chukwa Sulcata gathers the youngsters of his village to hear the story of Kachuva, a tortoise who agreed to fly home with two wild ducks by clamping his jaws onto the stick they carry between them. Some of the little ones doubt the tale is true, until Chukwa's old friend Chandra the wild duck shows up to confirm the details.
